AN ORDINANCE AMENDING

THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF DECATUR, GEORGIA

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Decatur, Georgia, and it is hereby ordained by the authority of the same, that:

- 1) Section 3.13 (a) (1) be deleted in its entirety and replaced with:
 - (a) (1) For the purpose of electing city commissioners, the city is divided into two election districts consisting of the described territory of the City of Decatur contained in the description attached to this Charter and made a part hereof and further identified as "Plan: DecaturCity2022".
- 2) In Sections 3.13 (b) (1), (2) and (3) the phrase "United States decennial census of 2010 for the State of Georgia" is replaced with "United States decennial census of 2020 for the State of Georgia."

Effective January 1, 2023.

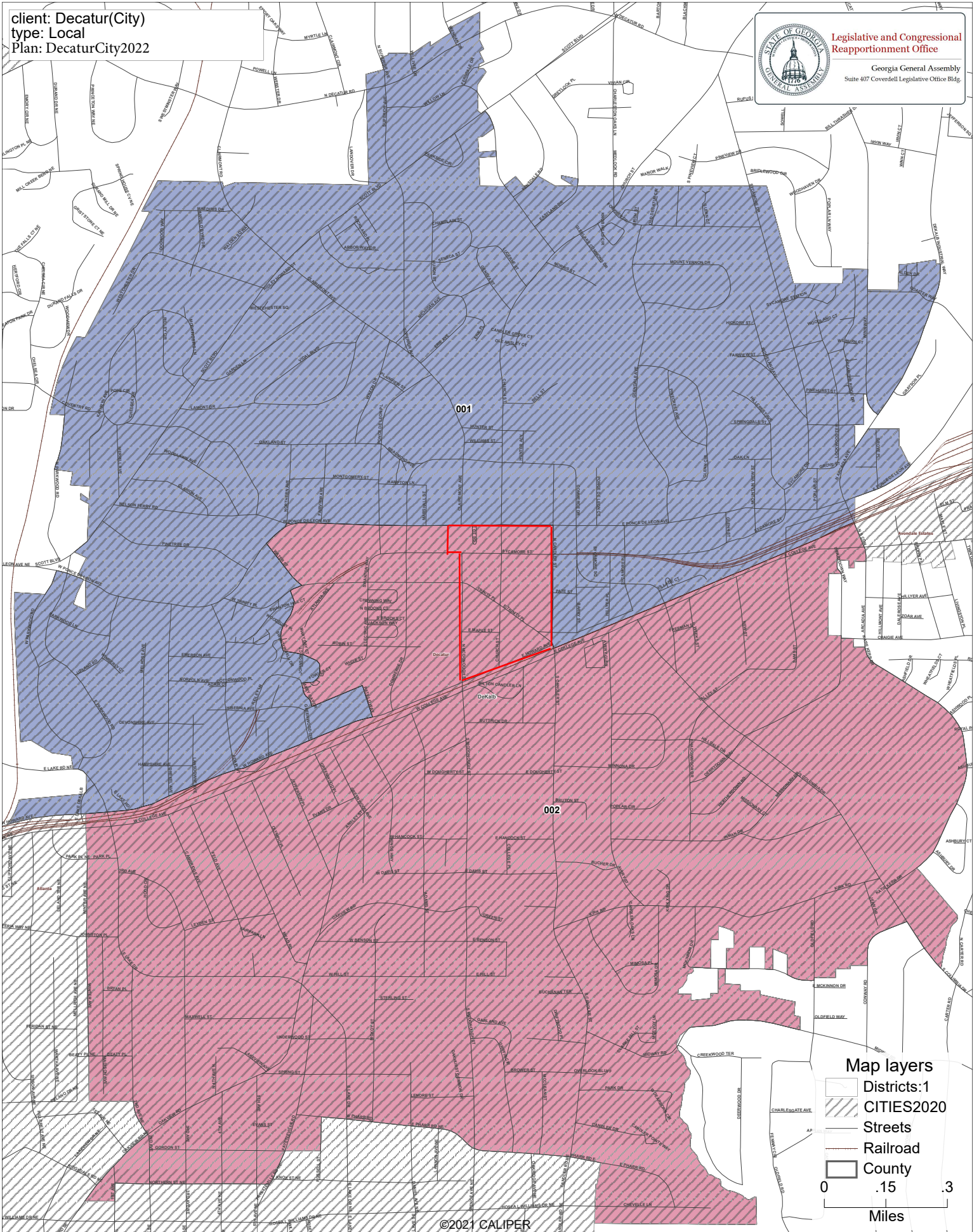

NOTICE OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO CITY CHARTER

Notice is hereby given that at its regular meetings on Monday, November 7, 2022 and on Monday, November 21, 2022, the Decatur City Commission will consider amending Section 3.13 (a)(1) of the City Charter to provide for amended election districts for the purpose of complying with the “one person, one vote” standard of the United States Constitution and the Georgia Constitution and will consider amending Sections 3.13 (b)(1), (2) and (3) of the City Charter to replace references to the United States Decennial census of 2010 with references to the United States Decennial census of 2020 . Meetings of the Decatur City Commission are held at 7:30 p.m. in the City Commission Meeting Room, Decatur City Hall, 509 North McDonough Street, Decatur, Georgia. Copies of the proposed amendments are available for public examination and inspection during regular business hours in the City Clerk’s Office and in the Clerk of Superior Court’s office.
